Jena Scarboro Awarded 2010 Frances and O. Z. Rollins Memorial Scholarship

As Deacon Ron Black announced at the conclusion of the worship service on August 15, Jena Scarboro has been selected as the 2010 recipient of the Rollins Scholarship.

A rising senior at Appalachian State University, Jena is pursuing a B.S. in Middle Grades Education. While at ASU, Jena has served as a Teaching Assistant for a professor who teaches North Carolina history. She has also tutored academically challenged middle school students through an organization known as the Western Youth Network, and she has tutored high school students through Upward Bound. Jena has done field research at schools in New York City and Washington, D.C., and she has served as an intern at Central Wilkes Middle School in Wilkesboro. Somehow she has made time to participate in ASU's outstanding marching band and to work, as she is able, in Blowing Rock as well as Morganton. In the process, Jena has compiled a most impressive academic record, including a 3.85 grade point average.

When Jena was growing up in our church, she was very active in all aspects of our children's and youth ministry. She served for several years as a volunteer assistant in our children's choirs, and she was a leader in our youth program. Jena also distinguished herself in many ways in our community, including working toward and fulfilling the requirements for her Girl Scout Gold Award in one of our First Baptist-sponsored Girl Scout troops. Jena still works hard, when she can, in her father Phil's catering business, Scarboro Fair.

Frances and O. Z. Rollins, a longtime teacher and chiropractor, respectively, and both longtime members of First Baptist Church, recognized the extreme importance of education at every level, but especially in the formative years. In honoring their memory, Randy Rollins, Vinton Rollins, and Dixie Berg, the Rollins' children, established the Rollins Scholarship Fund in 2001. The Scholarship is awarded annually to a member of First Baptist Church who is preparing, at the college level, to become a teacher (K-12).

The Rollins Scholarship Fund is one of eleven funds overseen and administered by our Trustees, presently chaired by Claude Sitton.

We congratulate Jena on receiving this high honor, and we pray for God's richest blessings for her as she continues her journey to fulfill her stated goal—to become a middle school teacher!

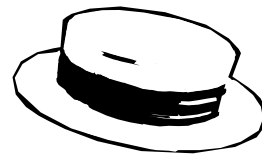
