PRICE CHANGE**

In September, 2009, we dropped the price of the Adult Meal to \$5.00 (while excluding the salad/soup bar in that price) to try to encourage more people to come to Church Family Night. However, we have been losing money each week. Certain costs remain the same whether or not you prepare for 80 people or 150 people. Without increased volume, we are going to have to raise the price of the adult meal back to \$6.00 per person. We will try to keep the Soup Bar during the winter months which will come with the Adult Meal, but when we start the salad bar in the spring and summer months, we will have to charge \$1.00 extra for the Salad Bar.

This price change will go into effect February 10th.
