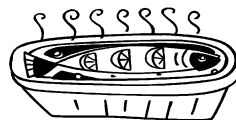

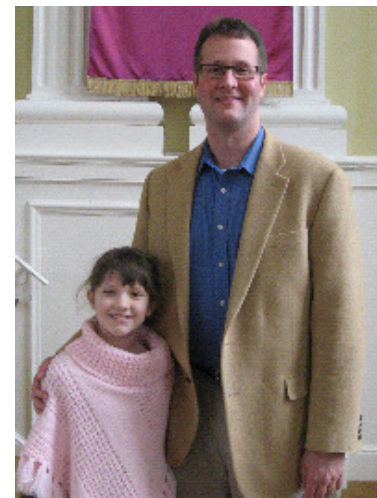
## EASTER LILIES
